Before engaging with Indigenous individuals and communities, use this checklist to ensure you are fully prepared:
□ Understand the community's cultural values, traditions, and history.
□ Build authentic relationships with community leaders and elders.
$\square$ Familiarize yourself with policies and systemic issues affecting Indigenous peoples.
□ Incorporate traditional healing practices and Indigenous knowledge into your work.
☐ Advocate for equitable access to resources and services.
□ Stay informed about local, regional, and national Indigenous policies.
□ Practice cultural humility and commit to lifelong learning.
□ Prioritize relationship-building over rigid timelines.
□ Collaborate with other professionals and organizations that serve Indigenous communities.
$\square$ Seek out mentors or resources to deepen your understanding of Indigenous social work.
